Helping the USSSA Pride, Callahan boasted a .277 batting average in the NPF last season, and played in 44 of 57 games. The Pride kept her in the lineup, though moving her on the field from first base to third base to even just in a designated hitter position.

At the University of Tennessee, and with Worth teammate Monica Abbott, Callahan was the 2008 SEC Player of the Year and a three-time first-team All-SEC selection (2006, 2007, 2008) for the Lady Vols. Callahan is still career leader in home runs, RBIs and total bases.

Schnake, one of the most colorful and thus memorable players in UGA softball history, in 2009 was named to the All-SEC Defensive Team and helped lead Georgia to its first ever Women's College World Series where she batted .222 with two doubles, three runs scored and five RBI. That year, she was crucial in helping Georgia post the nation's best team fielding percentage of .981 and finished 2009 with a place in the single-season record books, ranked tied fourth in sacrifice flies (4) and seventh in runs scored (52).
