MIZUNO AND JENNIE FINCH INK MULTI-YEAR AGREEMENT Fastpitch Softball's Biggest Star Re-Signs with Mizuno

Finch was one of the premier players on the USA Women's National Team which took home the Silver medal at the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games, and the Gold medal at the 2004 Athens Olympic Games. Before that, Finch was a three-time, first team All-American, and two-time Honda Player of the Year while playing for the University of Arizona. She is one of the most dominant pitchers in the history of fastpitch softball, and currently holds the NCAA record for most consecutive wins with 60.

"For almost a decade I have been proud to work with the Mizuno team on the Jennie Finch signature product line," said Finch. "Mizuno has enabled me to fulfill my dream of developing the best products for the fastpitch player, and I am thrilled to continue my relationship with a company that has believed in me and my dreams."
